The funds raised at the auction, are then are then placed into the funds that go to help all the over 2000 LOCAL kidney dialysis & transplant patients. The Kidney Foundation lends aid to these folks for medications, transportation, education for themselves and their families. They have on-going research projects also. This all takes a lot of \$\$\$\$.

So you say "how can I help??" Well you can donate your old car or truck to them so they can take it to the auction. Check with your tax preparer, but in most cases the donation is tax deductible.
